Adult, Collegiate and Synchro Figure Skating

The AdultSkate, CollegiateSkate and SynchroSkate programs are open to all skaters ages 18 or older who want to figure skate for fun and fitness in either a recreational or competitive setting. We follow Skate Canada's programs: CanSkate, StarSkate. Skaters can receive certified coaching, learn new skills, achieve tests, and compete with other university/college students or adults at different sanctioned events throughout the year. Harmony on Ice Adult III is a synchro team with 75% of skaters aged 35+ and competes at least twice per year. Skaters must hold an active Skate Canada membership with Glacier School of Skating or their existing club. Proof is required if your home club is not Glacier.
